
Recycled Glass Jar Lantern

Skill Level: EASY

Note: Kids will need adult assistance. Project requires use of with hammer and nail

Materials Needed:

- Glass Jar with lid (example: salsa or pasta sauce jar)
- String (yarn or twine)
- Paper Bag or Wrapping Paper
- Elmer's glue or similar
- Small paint brush
- Scissors
- Hammer
- Household nail
- Cutting Board





STEPS:

- Step 1: Cut thin paper bag strips the length & width of the jar.
- Step 2: Using a small paint brush, apply glue directly to the jar.
- Step 3: Glue strips vertically from top to bottom edges of the jar (leave space for light between the strips).
- Step 4: Glue strips horizontally across the jar to make a cross pattern (*again, leaving space between the strips to show glass*).
- Step 5: Place the jar lid on a cutting board or secure surface. Hammer a hole into the lid, wide enough for your string.
- Step 6: Cut the string your desired handle length, then tie ends into a knot. Thread the string through the nail hole of your lid (knot on the inside of the lid).
- Step 7: Put the lid back on the jar. Add any finishing artistic touches.

CREATIVE TIPS:

- Before you apply the paper strips to the jar, decorate them with crayons or markers.
- You can also use any decorative paper (wrapping paper or colored paper).
- Yarn or string is also a substitute for paper. Just be sure to leave space for the light to shine through!
- Remember --- if you decide to add embellishments, decorate the paper, not the jar.

SAFETY WARNING: Do not put candles or open flames in this lantern. Use battery operated lights only.
